With over 2,000 filed patents and numerous biotech start-ups, OMRF's discoveries have created millions in revenue and fueled private-sector growth, creating quality jobs and supporting the local economy.

In an analysis of OMRF's 2022 fiscal year, Applied Economics, LLC, found that the foundation had a **\$165 million total economic contribution** to Oklahoma's economy.
